

SUPERVISION OF SEX OFFENDERS IN THE COMMUNITY: **A Training Curriculum**

Outline of Section 1: An Overview of the Training

Time Allotment: 2 hours, 15 minutes, including up to 30 minutes for introductions.

Subject Matter: In addition to giving a brief overview of the training goals, this section introduces essential background materials. Sections on victims of sexual assault and sex offenders provide a solid basis on which to build the practices of comprehensive sex offender management. A section on an Emerging Approache to Sex Offender Management similarly offers a framework for understanding the challenges posed by this category of offender and the strategies that have emerged in response.

Learning Activities: The Learning Activity in this section invites participants to begin to examine the implications of these issues for their own work, creating motivation and context for the modules that follow.
